Total score for submission 50 points.

Important Notes:

- The award will not be made to the same person twice.
- Nominations are accepted from any party except the nominee.
- This category is awarded at the Canberra Region level only.
- The criteria and rules for entry for the Australian Tourism Awards DO NOT apply to this category.
- This award will be presented at the discretion of the judges, based on the submissions received.
- Maximum submission length is 2,500 words.

The judges will take into account the following aspects of the contribution when assessing a nomination.

OVERVIEW OF THE NOMINEE (10 points)

Provide a brief overview of the nominee, highlighting their outstanding attributes. Include a brief history of their career in tourism, and a description of their current employment or other participation, if applicable.

NOMINEE'S PROFESSIONAL CONTRIBUTION AND SERVICE (20 marks)

Provide examples and the benefits of the nominee's professional contribution and service to the tourism industry.

BENEFITS TO THE INDUSTRY AND SUCCESS (20 marks)

Provide specific examples of volunteer activities undertaken by the nominee that have helped advance the Canberra Region's tourism industry.

REFEREES

Enclose three references to support this nomination addressing each of the following.

- a) Leadership
- b) Positive Contribution and Influence
- c) Mentoring
